

Frequently Asked Questions about the Discount Prescription Drug Card Program

How do I use the Discount Drug Card?

Simply present your card at one of the 58,000 participating pharmacies to start saving. You can ask your pharmacist to input your card ID into the pharmacy's system; this will eliminate the need to present your card each time you fill a prescription.

Can I give it to friends or co-workers to use?

Yes, absolutely! It can be used by anyone, including family members and friends. We would especially encourage you to share this program with anyone who does not have prescription drug benefits.

What does it cost me?

Nothing! No obligation! There is no cost to you.

Do I need a prescription to get the discount?

Yes, you will need a prescription from your physician to obtain the discount. Employees with medical insurance can present both cards to the pharmacy and choose the greater discount. However, double discounts are not allowed.

What prescription medications are discounted through the Discount Drug Card program?

Thousands of medications, both brand name and generic, along with several over-the-counter "lifestyle" medications, such as smoking cessation aids and diabetes supplies, are included.

Many of the pet medications prescribed by your veterinarian have a "human counterpart" that may be discounted. Ask your veterinarian for a prescription and have it filled at a participating pharmacy, rather than your veterinarian's office, to take advantage of available discounts.

"I have used the prescription drug card and was excited to save nearly \$20 on a \$35 amount when I needed two prescriptions. That was the first time I used the card. Since then, I have picked up prescriptions for very little cost to myself.
